Ministry tasks:

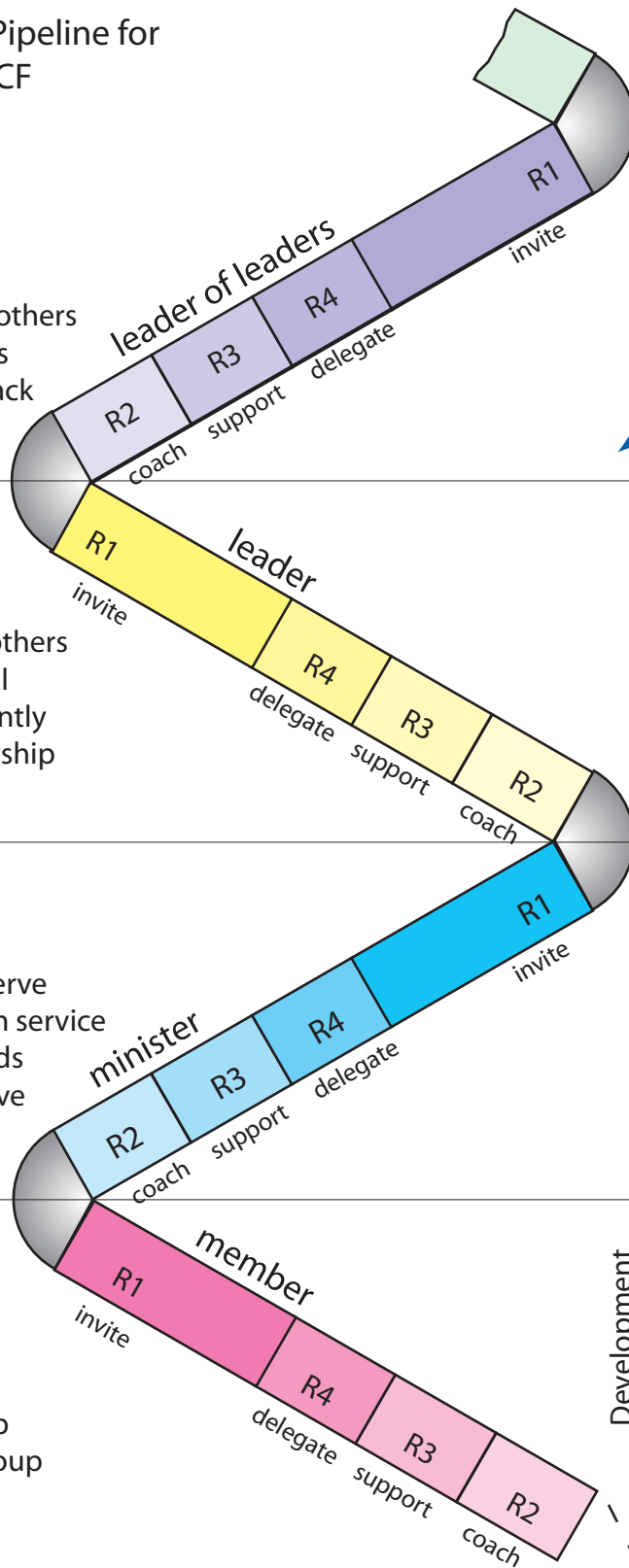
- respond to requests to serve
